Stop Residential Hotel Fires!

Over the last 14 years, over 1,700 residential hotel units have been lost to fire in San Francisco. Six hotels now stand vacant due to fire on 6th Street alone, representing 738 units of much-needed low-cost housing. Come to a vigil for victims of fires and call on the city to:

- Enforce the new Sprinkler Ordinance that requires all residential hotels to have sprinklers in every room by June 30, 2002.
- Extend the vouchers for the survivors of the recent Baldwin House Hotel fire until they are able to move back in.
- Rebuild burned down hotels and increase this city's stock of low-cost housing.
