

Give planning power to the people, not the developers!

Proposition D is designed to give us a voice in policies that guide future development decisions in San Francisco.

Proposition D will:

- give neighbors a voice by giving District Supervisors-- who have to be more accountable to neighborhoods-- a share of appointments to the Planning Commission and the Board of Permit Appeals.
- protect Planning Commissioners from pressure by politicians by allowing them to be removed only for official misconduct, and not at the whim of a politician.

The Planning Commission and the Board of Permit Appeals make decisions about land use and planning for the city. They recently ruled on the West Cork Hotel's attempted conversion from a residential to a tourist hotel. Only after months of delays and massive community pressure did they decide to follow city zoning law and keep the hotel residential. We should not have to fight so hard every time to protect residential hotels and enforce San Francisco's planning laws.
